STATE ROUTE 86 PEDESTRIAN STUDY

FACT SHEET

The Arizona Department of Transportation and the Tohono O'odham Nation are teaming up to improve pedestrian access along State Route 86 through Sells.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project team will study the project area, collect data and make recommendations on needed improvements. The study area includes a three-mile corridor of ADOT right of way along SR 86 through the Town of Sells, beginning east of the Tohono O'odham Utility Authority and ending west of the Indian-Oasis Baboquivari Unified School District Administration Building. A map of the project area is included below. For a more detailed map of Sells, visit the Sells district office or go online at www.tonation-nsn.gov/.

Recommended improvements may include:

- Sidewalk placement
- Lighting plans
- Pedestrian seating areas
- Crosswalk locations



The SR 86 Pedestrian Access Study is scheduled to be a six-month process. ADOT team members will present the project to the Sells community at the first community meeting on Sept. 27, 2011. Data collection will continue through November 2011. A final report is expected to be released by January 2012.

Public input is a vital part of the project.

Individuals who live and work within the town of Sells or who travel along SR 86 regularly are encouraged to provide their feedback by completing a project survey. Surveys are available at the Sells District Office and online at www.tonation-nsn.gov.
