The Tohono O'odham Nation provides an opportunity for artists and craftsmen to display and sell their wares. A 10' X 10' vendor space is available at the cost of \$100.00 for Native Americans (tribal member must be present in booth at all times) and \$200.00 for Non-Native Americans for the entire four (4) days of the Rodeo & Fair. Complete applications with full payment shall be mailed or paid in person at: Tohono O'odham Nation Rodeo & Fair, **Treasury Dept.** P.O. Box 837 Sells, AZ 85634. Payment is Non-Refundable and only money order payment will be accepted (Cash is acceptable if paying in person). Payments are to be made payable to Tohono O'odham Nation Rodeo & Fair. Vendor spaces will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. Upon receipt of your complete application and full payment you will be assigned a space and we will call you with your space number. Times for booth set-up will be as follows: Thursday, February 5, 8 a.m. – 3 p.m. Friday, Saturday & Sunday February 6, 7 & 8, 2009 set-up will end at 8:00 a.m. One vehicle per vendor is allowed inside the fair grounds during setup times. On site sharing of spaces will not be allowed and will subject vendor to immediate removal. Vendors are to keep space reasonably clean and clear of trash. Vendors must supply own tables, chairs, electricity (generator), space structure and other equipment needed. Items sold by vendors that are determined by appropriate local authorities to be hazardous, harmful or damaging to the public or property as well as items of endangered species, sacred ceremonial status or prehistoric artifacts will immediately cease to be sold when directed by appropriate local authorities. Failure to comply with the set-up times described above and these regulations may result in immediate removal, including all vehicles affiliated with the vendor space, from the Fair Grounds. \_\_\_\_\_ Vendor initials
