The Tohono O'odham Nation provides an opportunity for artists and craftsmen to display and sell their wares. A 10' X 10' vendor space is available @ the cost of \$100.00 for Native American (proof required and member(s) must be present in booth at all times) and \$300.00 for Non-Native Americans for the DAYS (3) days of the Rodeo & Fair. Payment will be accepted by money orders only and made payable to: Tohono O'odham Nation Rodeo & Fair Attn. Treasury Dept. P.O. Box 837 Sells, AZ 85634. Spaces will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. In addition to the stated fee all vendors are required to obtain a Transaction Privilege Tax License issued by the Office of the Treasury; pursuant to Title 22-Taxation, Chapter 2-Transaction Privilege Tax, Section 3. Definitions (12)'Retailer', Section 4. Privilege License, B. Retail License. The fee for the Transaction Privilege License is five dollars (\$5.00). Upon receipt of your completed application and payment in full you will be assigned a space. Times for set-up will be as follows: Friday January 27, 2017 @ 7:00 AM, Saturday and Sunday January 28 & 29, 2017, MUST BE SET UP BY 7 AM. NO exceptions on set up. You will be allowed one vehicle per vendor during setup times. ALL VEHICLES MUST VACATE THE GROUNDS PRIOR TO THE GATES OPENING. On site sharing of spaces will not be allowed and will be subject to removal or additional fee charged. Vendors are to keep space respectably clean and clear of trash. Vendors must supply own 10x10 canopy, tables, chairs, electricity (generator), space structure and other equipment as needed. Items sold by Vendors that are determined by appropriate local authorities to be hazardous, harmful or damaging to the public or property as well as items of endangered species, sacred ceremonial status or prehistoric artifacts will immediately cease to be sold when directed by appropriate local authorities. Failure to abide with set-up times described above and these regulations may result in immediate removal, including all vehicles affiliated with the vendor space, from the Rodeo & Fair Grounds.
