Power Outage Summary

On Monday May 8, 2017 at approximately 9:12 P.M. the Tohono O'odham Utility Authority (TOUA) experienced a catastrophic equipment failure that was due to a storm in TOUA's service territory. Power was restored on May 10 at 7:11 P.M., lasting 45 hours and 59 minutes.

The equipment failure resulted in a power outage that affected 3,186 customers served by TOUA. Affected areas were Pima and Pinal counties within the main reservation of the Tohono O'odham Nation with the exception of two areas Garcia Strip and Golden Ha:san Casino.

The power outage did not affect the San Xavier and San Lucy Districts or Florence Village.
