Early Voting for Aug. 28 Primary Election is Underway

The primary election for federal, state and local races is next Tuesday, August 28. If you are voting by mail, please complete and mail your ballot by Thursday, August 23 in order for it to arrive by Election Day. If you aren't able to mail your ballot by Aug. 23, you can still drop it off at any polling place in your county on Election Day.

Early voting sites are also open through Friday this week in Pima, Pinal, and Maricopa Counties if you wish to cast an early ballot in person. Early voting sites include:
