Veterans Day Parade

November 11, 2019 at 0900

- Registration and check in will start at 0730 at the entrance to Federal Route 24 (Big Fields Rd.)
- Parade lineup will begin at 0730
- The parade will begin at 0900 November 11, 2019
- All roads will close at 0830
- Entries will be given approximately 40 feet of set-up space to prepare for the parade. This includes the space to park and decorate your entry and one more assisting vehicle.

In addition to applicable laws of the Tohono O'odham Nation, the following safety rules are added to keep the parade enjoyable for all participants and spectators. Failure to abide by the rules listed below may result in immediate removal from the parade lines.

- 1. All Participants under 10 years of age must be supervised by a responsible adult designated by the child's parent/guardians.
- 2. No one <u>under</u> 12 years of age will be allowed to ride alone on horseback
- 3. All entries must begin at the starting point at Federal Route 24 (Big Fields Rd.)
- 4. All-Terrain Vehicles (ATV) will **not** be allowed to participate in the parade
- 5. All performances to be limited to 30 seconds at each announcement.
- 6. All entries must stay in their assigned set up space until notified by the lineup crew.
- 7. Tossing of candies or incentives from vehicles is **<u>prohibited</u>**. Walking along and passing out such items is allowed.
- 8. Candies must be passed out in <u>clear plastic bags</u>.
- Float entries must proceed to your assigned take down space at the end of the parade as instructed.
- 10. Any kind of noise makers (Loud Poppers) are absolutely not allowed
- 11. All entries must end at the <u>parking lot in front of Legislative Chambers</u>, floats with trailers will continue to designated area. (In the event of weather or other concerns you will be redirected if needed)
