<del></del>	-Tribal Enrollment Status (AUTHORIZATION TO REQUEST TRIBAL VERIFICATION form):  Submit the signed form to askeap@tonation nsn.gov, or mail to Education Assistance Program, P.O. 837,  Sells Az 85634.
	Official Transcripts:  Must submit most recent official transcripts.  Official Transcripts are certified by school's registrar's office and either mailed directly to the program or hand delivered in original unbroken, sealed envelope.
<del></del>	- <u>Diploma</u> A copy of your High School or GED diploma
<del></del>	- <u>Acceptance Letter:</u> Letter of acceptance from the institution you will be attending.
	<u>Class Schedule:</u> A Class Schedule is required from the institution you are attending. This will verify if you are a full-time or a part-time student.
	<u>Program of Study:</u> A listing of the required classes you need to complete your program/degree. You will need to see a school advisor to obtain this document.
	Student Aid Report (SAR):  Complete and submit Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Please apply at www.fafsa.ed.gov online. FAFSA results will be returned to you from FAFSA, which is called an SAR. Submit a copy of SAR.
	<u>Financial Needs Analysis (FNA):</u> Complete the top portion of your FNA. Your financial aid officer will fill out the bottom portion of your form. This form will not be completed until you have applied for Pell (FAFSA). (Check with your financial aid officer to make sure they have your completed FAFSA on file.)
	W- 9 Form: All recipients must complete and sign a W-9 Form. This form is required by the Tohono O'odham Nation in order to process payment to anyone receiving fund from the Tohono O'odham Nation.
