Bring Necessary ID

Make sure to bring identification, like a driver's license or similar government photo ID. You can use your Tribal ID, but you will need a second form of ID that has your address. If you don't have any of these forms of identification, you can bring two non-photo IDs with your name and address, like a utility bill or a voter registration card.

Where to Early Vote

For Pima County voters, the TOKA Community Building in Sells is hosting early voting from 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. through Friday, July 29. It will also be open for emergency early voting on Saturday, July 30 from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. and Monday, August 1, from 9am – 4:00 p.m.

If you received a vote by mail ballot and haven't sent it in, please drop it off in person at an early voting center or your polling place (typically your District office).
