Objective

Through partnerships built with the Tohono O'odham Nation Executive Office, the Nation is set to receive two brand-new basketball courts. The project is being spearheaded by the Executive Office, in collaboration with the Tohono O'odham Nation Youth Council, and is currently seeking input from Nation members on identifying suitable locations for the new courts.

The "Alley-Oop Challenge" is a call-to-action for Nation members to submit a written proposal explaining why their community should be selected for the construction of a new basketball court. The contest is open to all members of the Nation with youth being the target audience.

Rules & Criteria

- Must work with local leadership to making sure the land being recommended is suitable for construction (i.e. Chairman, Vice Chair, District Council, Community Representatives)
- Must submit written proposal answering the four questions listed in the call to action.
- Submission must be made by enrolled tribal member of the district that they are submitting a proposal for.
