- Wash your hands frequently. Take hand sanitizer with you to festivities.
- Scare away the germs!
- Although most restrictions on activity have been lifted, it's wise to be cautious and avoid indoor crowds with activities that involve many people touching the same surfaces.

## Look out for ghouls!

- Have a flashlight for everyone who is walking outdoors at night.
- Wear reflective tape or clothes.
- Decide on a meeting place if someone gets lost.

## Watch out for scary potions and brews!

- Check treats before you or kids eat them.
- Only eat candy and treats from people you know and with sealed wrappings.
- Apples, pencils, toys, and books make great Halloween treats.
- Be aware of candy look-a-likes that are deadly drugs like Rainbow Fentanyl.
- Request a free nasal Naloxone antidote at any pharmacy if someone you know might be at risk for fentanyl overdose.
- Avoid alcohol and other drugs.
- Designate a driver to get you home safely.
