To manage and improve the Nation's rangelands and is responsible for range developments that will enhance the Nation's rangelands so these resources can be used in a sustainable manner.

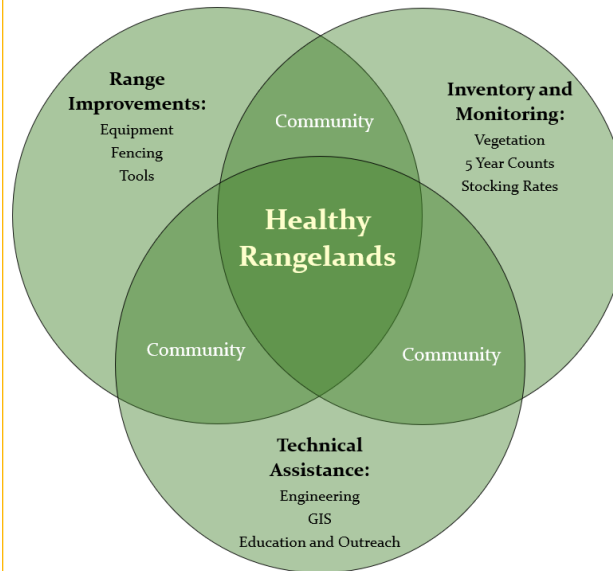
The Range Conservation and Management Program is broken up into three sections:

## **A Healthy Range Provides Many Services for the Nation:**

- ◆ Erosion and Flood Control
- ◆ Dust suppression
- ◆ Surface and groundwater supplies
- ◆ Food for Livestock and wildlife
- ◆ Traditional Food, Medicine, and Materials



## **Types of Assistance RCMP Provides:**

- ◆ Range Condition Monitoring and Holding Capacity #'s for Livestock
- ◆ Fence Clearing
- ◆ Land Clearing/Brush Management
- ◆ Small Scale Erosion and Flood Control Engineering and Installation
- ◆ Charco Engineering, Installation, and Repair
  - ◆ Charcos must be permitted with the *Water Resources Department*
- ◆ Range Road Grading
- ◆ Provide Some Materials and Supplies like Fencing, Troughs, or Hay During Drought
- ◆ Range Mapping
- ◆ Workshops
