Qualifications

Miss Tohono O'odham contestant MUST meet the following qualifications.

- 1. Be an enrolled member of the Tohono O'odham Nation. Submit a copy of your tribal identification card.
- 2. Be 17-24 years of age.
- Knowledgeable of or will be willing to learn the Tohono O'odham language, culture, history, values, traditions, and issues affecting our tribal government.
- 4. Have a high school diploma or GED; or be currently attending high school or GED program.
 - a. Must have a GPA of 2.5 or above when application is submitted include attendance record.
 - b. A certified copy of high school transcript.
 - c. GED certificate.
- 5. Submit two (2) letters of recommendation on an official letterhead from any of the following:
 - a. Clergy.
 - b. Academic counselor.
 - c. Teacher.
 - d. Leader of community or other professional.
- 6. Have a positive character.
- 7. Able to communicate to the public and participate in traditional and non-O'odham activities.
- 8. Be a recruiter for contestants for the Miss Tohono Oʻodham title and share the benefits of being Miss Tohono Oʻodham.

6. Impromptu Questioning.
