Guidelines for the 2022-2023 virtual pageant

- 1. Everyone must wear a mask during the pageant including the crowning presentation.
- 2. Contestants will be scheduled to come to a central location to record their part of the pageant. Location and times to be determined.
- 3. You will be recorded one time per presentation. Be prepared to perform as soon as you arrive. If you are using props you will be required to set up and breakdown your items.

QUALIFICATIONS

A Miss Tohono O'odham contestant MUST meet the following qualifications

- 1. Be an enrolled member of the Tohono O'odham Nation. Submit a copy of your Tribal identification card.
- 2. Be 17-24 years of age.
- 3. Be knowledgeable of or be willing to learn the Tohono O'odham language, culture, history, values, traditions and issues affecting our Tribal government.
- 4. Have a high school diploma or GED; be attending high school or a GED program. Must have a GPA of 2.5 or above when application is submitted and include attendance record. A certified copy of your most recent high school transcript or verification of GED program attendance from the school you are attending.
- 5. Submit two(2) letters of recommendation on official letterhead from any of the following: Clergy, Academic Counselor, Teacher, Leaders in the Community, or other Professional(s).
- 6. Be a reputable person.
- 7. Be willing and able to communicate with the public and participate in Traditional and non-O'odham activities.

Please submit two photos dressed in your Traditional Attire with your application. One photo must be a head shot and the second photo will be full, body length. These are for advertisement of the Pageant.

PAGEANT RULES

- As a Miss Tohono O'odham Nation contestant, you will participate in and be judged on the following:
 - 1. Oral Presentation (INTRODUCTION INCLUDED, 3 MINUTE TIME LIMIT)
 - 2. Essay Writing
 - 3. Interview Session
 - 4. Talent
 - 5. Modeling Traditional Dress
 - 6. Impromptu Questioning
- As a contestant, your talent shall be no longer than 5 minutes.
- In your application, you <u>must submit</u> an accurate description of your Traditional dress. Once your application is accepted by the Pageant Committee you <u>will not</u> be permitted to submit any changes.
- You shall arrive for the all scheduled recording on time and be prepared. The Committee may approve a request with prior notice.
- At all times you must be respectful of yourself, other contestants and the Pageant Committee.
- You are responsible for your personal belongings at all times during Pageant Week. The Miss Tohono O'odham Nation Committee is not responsible for loss of personal items, theft or injury while you are a contestant.
