Brief Summary: The research project aims to conduct a survey in GuVo and Pisinemo Districts about Little Free Library book sharing boxes. Through the proposed project, LFL and NAAF will assess the influence of the existing book boxes on book access, attitudes toward reading, and reading habits. The project will also identify opportunities to strengthen efforts to improve book access in the Tohono O'odham Nation as part of NAAF's broader educational and literacy initiatives.

The Tohono O'odham Nation's Institutional Review Board (IRB) was established to oversee the Research Code that was enacted and codified as 17 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 8 by Resolution No. 13-165 effective May 23, 2013.
