The Tohono O'odham Nation has filed a lawsuit against the U.S. Department of Homeland security to stop its plans to take our reservation land and water to construct a border wall.

For decades, the Tohono O'odham Nation has cooperated with the federal government's border security measures. Together, we have been successful in protecting the U.S. homeland without resorting to an ineffective wall that would take our land, separate our people, desecrate sacred areas, and cause great harm to the natural environment.

The federal government has chosen to disregard our sovereignty. We have been left with no other choice but to sue it. Our priority must always be to protect our people, our culture, and to stand up for what is right.
